



Mediterranean, Middle East & Africa Agents

KUWAIT: GLOBAL FREIGHT SYSTEMS

- Agent is fully operational but with restricted hours (closing 1.00PM) but reachable by phone & emails
- Kuwait Port Authority and Customs are operational
- Shipping line, airline offices are open for half a day
- Airport opened for cargo only: only EK, QR, TK are operating
- Ports & customs are open, but process is slow down because of skeleton staff
- Vessels are discharged but slow

JORDAN: JADARA FORWARDING & SHIPPING LTD

- Staff is perating from office on daily working shifts from 10 am – 1:00 pm (1 operation, 1 accounting and 1 customer service), the rest of the staff working remotely from home
- Customs clearance dept./service centers: operating smoothly and with priority with less working hours and on working shifts at Amman airport and Aqaba port.
- All land boarder points are closed today at the weekend at our side, except for Al Omari Boarder point Jordan – KSA.
- AIR:
 - Import shipments are handled by airport operator/Authority normally but with limited working hours
 - Export services is very limited and about to shut down
- SEA: operations are working smoothly with limited working hours and skeleton staff
- Land: Import/Export from & to nearby countries (Syria, Iraq, Israel, occupied territory – west bank of Palestine) is blocked till further notices, except for land boarder point with KSA (Only one point working for Al Omari Boarder point Jordan – KSA).

LEBANON: MASAFAT INTERNATIONAL SAL

- Customs are opened
- Most of the trading and industry companies are closed too until 29/3/2020
- Staff is operating from Monday to Friday from 8.30AM until 2PM with precautionary measures
- Business is handled on regular basis.
- Sea ports:
 - Sea ports activity is still open for imports and exports from Beirut and Tripoli ports
 - Not all shipping lines are following same measures or hours of work, however service is regularly provide but with delay
- Airlines:
 - Beirut Intl airport is still functional for cargo flights and Diplomatic, Military, Air Ambulance flights and Personnel related to the Oil drilling operations in Block 4.
 - All commercial and private flights are stopped until 29/3/2020.
 - Only Cargo carriers coming into Lebanon is Cargolux with very reduced capacity (One flight per week)
- Road: no special restriction yet

SAUDI ARABIA: TRANS FREIGHT PROJECTS & LOGISTCS Ltd (TFPL)

- TFPL's staff is working remotely as of Sunday morning but you can reach your usual TFPL contact by email or phone.
- BL exchange/DO collection will work as usual but with safety measures.



- No international flights since 14 March for a period of 15 days.
- Shipping lines: Cargo traffic (breakbulk/containers/ro-ro) continue working.
- All private offices have been required to reduce the number of staff in office.
- Airlines / shipping lines: operating with skeleton staff
- Customs: slower. Free time at ports have now been increased from 2+3 days to 10 days, meaning some delays are expected.
- Port Authorities “Mawani “and KSA Customs announced continuity of business activities in all Saudi ports.
- Imports & exports continue to flow seamlessly with safety measures.

EGYPT: EGYTRANS

- Egytrans is working in fully operational till now.
- Air Flights suspended from 19th March till 31st March (excluding freighters).
- Imported cargo to be examined, fumigated & approved by Quarantine Health Department before the stevedoring & before performing custom clearance.
- Terminals/ Yards examined temperature control for the daily visitors.
- Most of Shipping lines/ agencies still working in full power & few of them reduced the employees for 50%.
- Imported cargo to be examined, fumigated & approved by Quarantine Health Department before the stevedoring & before performing custom clearance.
- Delivering shipments/Trucking still working normally (Import & Export)

MALTA: CARMELO CARUANA

- Staff operational
- SEA Import/Export: Returning to normal as China resumes production and equipment situation improves.
- ROAD Import/Export: Effected and operating slower than usual due to border controls and driver shortages.
- AIR Import/Export: Heavily Effected by the cancellation of several flights of international and national airlines.

CYPRUS: PHOTOS FORWARDING Ltd

- Staff fully operational with precautionary measures
- Customs & port authority offices are opened but with limited activity
- Our offices are opened and work normally. Some employees working from home.
- Sea ports:
 - Limassol sea port is open (limited activity)
 - Customs clearing delays due to limited accessibility. Food shipments have been given priority
 - Shipping lines announced to work partially from home and offices are not accessible to any third parties
- Airport:
 - Larnaca International airport will be open ONLY for cargo aircrafts from 21-3-20.
 - Airlines increased the freight rates due to the limited capacity.
 - Less workforce at the airport
- Road transport Situation:
 - Working as normal



OMAN: FALCON AIR SERVICES

- Staff is operational
- Seaports: Salalah, Sohar and Muscat are functioning as per normal
- Airports: Muscat International Airport opened for cargo only & freighter operations continue from UAE.
- Road: Access to UAE via Border crossing is permitted for Cargo Vehicles. Release of Trucks is delayed as stringent check are carried out on Personnel and Cargo.
- Generally, no impact as of now on Export Cargo movements.

ETHIOPIA: SAMATRA LOGISTICS & SHIPPING PLC

- Port of Entry is Djibouti as Ethiopia is a landlocked country. Delayed Empty containers coming back from Ethiopia for cargo in transit are not evacuated fast enough from the port causing delays in discharging the trucks & accrued demurrage for potential importers to Ethiopia. This applies to all shipping lines.
- Sea: Most shipping lines and free-zone facilities are working normal for the time being

NIGERIA: LIBRA CIRCLE

- Operations are normal for the time being

EAST AFRICA: KENFREIGHT (Kenya/Tanzania/Uganda/ Burundi)

- Kenfreight' staff remains fully operational in all above listed countries.
- No transport related barriers issues (customs or trucking).
- No disruption of airlines and shipping lines

MAURITIUS: Velogic Mautitius

- Island is lock down and confinement in place
- Staff work from home
- Air: many flights are cancelled and tomorrow is last EK flight
- Sea: No restrictions currently

MADAGASCAR: Velogic Ltd

- Air:
 - Air Mauritius has suspend all its flight to Madagascar until April 30, 2020.
 - Air France weekly freighter service every Thursday is still being maintained
 - Turkish Airlines maintains Sunday call.
 - Due to space scarcity, it is highly advisable to proceeding with bookings at least 4 days prior.
- Sea: 3 vessels are still at Tamatave under quarantine, while the port is operating normally.

MALI: Global Package Express

- Fully operational
- PAX flight from/to infected countries
- No barriers, containers from Dakar to Bamako are still crossing the border.
- EHS put in place standard health precautionary measures for the staff
- Airport & Customs are operating as usual
- Airlines: CAO flights are still operating like CV.



GABON - CONGO - RWANDA: AGS Group

- Gabon: Curfew in place since March 22nd, 2020
- Rwanda:
 - Operational, remote work, all technic team on field, 50% sales and administration
 - Airport: Lock down from today for 30 days
- Congo Brazzaville:
 - Staff operational for the time being

ANGOLA/MOZAMBIQUE/CAP VERDE : TIBA Group

- Staff are fully operational in each country

CAMEROUN: MOVIS CAMEROUN

- Staff is operational precautionary & safety measures
- Air: only cargo flights are allowed
- Sea ports:
 - Vessel transporting consumer products and essential goods and materials, whose stopover times will be limited and supervised
 - The vessels are inspected at the base buoy by the port authorities
 - Only dockers formally called to work will be allowed to enter the port precinct.
- Road: National road transport of goods is permitted, and trade between Cameroon and Chad and RCA continues.

GHANA: MOVIS GHANA

- Offices remaining operational with skeleton staff & work from home is in place.
- Sea ports: Sea ports are open, however a strict supervision of high-risk ships, port tours and academic internship.
- Air lines:
 - No ban on cargo incoming and outgoing.
 - Turkish, Emirates, KLM, Egypt, Qatar Airlines have suspended their services until further notice
 - Kotoka International Airport complies with suspension slot rules.
 - Suspension of all flights from EU areas
- Road: no specific disruption

REPUBLIC DEMOCRATIC OF CONGO: CONNEXAFRICA

- Staff fully operational with progressive implementation of work from home
- Safety & precautionary measures in place for those who need to work on site & shifts
- Port: Cargo plan are still allowed and the port of Matadi are running normally.

REUNION:

- Staff remains fully operational.
- The island is place in quarantine, same situation than in France mainland.
- Shipping lines: No vessel this week due to Mauritius is placing vessels coming from Reunion island.
- Airlines: Inter-islands flights are suspended, and the number of flights to France mainland are drastically reduced.



DJIBOUTI: TRANSIT MARILL

- Staff is operating full-time, under normal conditions, but with reinforced safety measures.
- Port: Delayed Empty containers coming back from Ethiopia for cargo in transit are not evacuated fast enough from the port causing delays in discharging the trucks & accrued demurrage for potential importers to Ethiopia. This applies to all shipping lines.
- Sea: Most shipping lines and free-zone facilities are working normal for the time being
- Air: Air France has been cancelled this morning
- Road & sea borders : uner strong monitoring
